THE USS BONHOMME RICHARD



BACKGROUND

On Sunday, July 12, 2020, a fire broke out onboard the USS Bonhomme Richard (LHD 6) (BHR) in the lower vehicle storage compartment. The fire burned for five days, spread to 11 of 14 decks, and reached temperatures in excess of 1,400 degrees Fahrenheit. The fire resulted in more than \$3B dollars in damage and a later decision to decommission what would have been one of the US Navy's most combat-capable amphibious assault ships.

- **TIMELINE Explosion after 3HRS**
- **0750** Fire starts (estimate)
- 0802 Lower V looks foggy
- 0810 Crewman reports to OOD
- 0814 OOD reports to DC central
- 0815 Investigator is dispatched
- 0817 Investigator calls away incident to OOD
- 0818 OOD tells DC Central to call it away
- 0822 OOD hears nothing so is called away at OD
- 0826 FEDFire is dispatched
- **0829** FEDFire arrives at ship.
- 0829 DC locker is manned and ready
- **0839** FEDFIRE evaluates situation
- 0838 Shipboard FF initial gets to lower V
- 0925 SDFD tries to find fire
- **0930** FedFire assumes control
- 0933 SDFD finds fire
- 0935 FEDFIRE & SDFD encounter each other in upper V (NO Water on fire)
- 0940 EDO ordered IET to exit ...
- **0944** SDFD reenters BHR Lower deck but leaves due to ship unfamiliarity
- 0944 Aft shore power secured *integration point
- 0951 FIRST AGENT ON FIRE after 2hrs
- 1037 Evacuation ordered
- **1050 USS BONHOMME EXPLODES BURNS FOR APPROX 5 DAYS**
